



Sailing Safely At Stone Horse

Safety on the water is paramount to SHYC. It is the requirement of each skipper to ensure that their boat has all the proper safety equipment aboard at all times. The following are the minimum equipment requirements.

There will be one announced safety inspection and one spot inspection during the sailing season. Failure to comply with required safety gear with result in disqualification from racing for that day or until safety equipment is complete.

Flying Scot

PFD - one for each crew member
Throwable PFD device or cushion/ring
Anchors – At least 8 lbs. with 100 feet of anchor line.
Whistle or horn
Paddle
Bailer
Compass
Safety line attached to the transom mooring rings
bow bag floatation
transom port drain

420's

PFD – one for each crew member
Whistle
Bailer with tether
Handheld Compass (recommended)

Opti's

PFD – one for each crew member
Bowline with 8 meters of line
Opti Paddle
Inflated air bags
Whistle
Bailer with tether
Handheld Compass (recommended)

Waterbug

PFD – one for each crew member
Bowline with 8 meters of line
Whistle
Bailer with tether
Paddle
Handheld Compass (recommended)
